[X] carboprost (HEMABATE) injection	250 mcg, intramuscular, once PRN, Bleeding that saturates a pad in less than 15 minutes if BP GREATER than 140/90, or if bleeding continues to saturate a pad in LESS than 15 minutes after Methergine administration, For 1 Doses, Postpartum  For bleeding that saturates a pad in less than 15 minutes, if blood pressure is greater than 140/90, or if bleeding continues to saturate a pad in less than 15 minutes after Methergine administration.
Mild Pain (Pain Score 1-3) Ibuprofen may be given in conjunction with hydrocodone-ac oxycodone-acetaminophen (PERCOCET) 5/325 mg for more
