Electronically Prescribe Controlled Substances

To e-prescribe controlled substances in Epic, you must first install the **SecureAuth Authenticate** app on your smartphone. This app is required as a secondary form of authentication when e-prescribing controlled substances to confirm you're the authorizing provider.

To Get Started:

- Download the **SecureAuth Authenticate** app from the [Apps Store](#) for iOS or [GooglePlay](#) for Android.

Setup

- From your computer, logon to: <https://auth.houstonmethodist.org/secureauth85/>.
- Enter your Username (Houston Methodist network ID) and password.
 - The **Setup Multi-Factor Authentication** window will open.
- Keep this page open then return to your mobile device to continue the process.

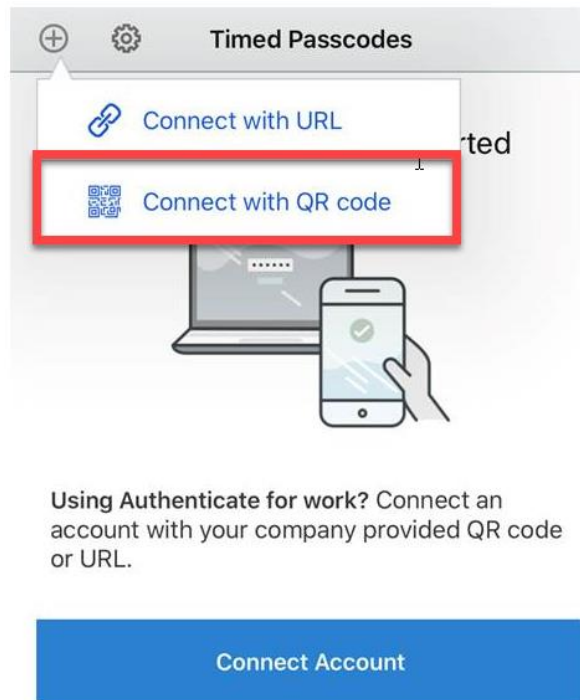
Setup Multi-Factor Authentication

- 1. Install**
To use multi-factor authentication, you will need to download the SecureAuth Authenticate mobile app to your smart phone
- 2. Scan**
Open your multi-factor authentication app and scan the code with the camera on your phone.
- 3. Confirm**
Enter the verification code generated by your multi-factor authentication app.
