Below are instructions on how to create your Learning Management System (LMS) account and register for and complete an Epic Personalization Lab.

Create your Learning Management System (LMS) Account

An LMS account allows you to search and register for training and start online courses. If you already have an LMS account, refer to the **Register for your Personalization Lab** section below.

- 1. Navigate to the LMS SuccessFactors site by clicking this link.
- 2. Toward the bottom, under **New User**, click the **Click here to register** hyperlink.
- 3. Complete all *Required Fields.
- 4. For **Employee #**, you can use a combination of any numbers or letters, that will be easy for you to remember. This will be your LMS login.

Register for Your Personalization Lab

Important

- You must be a current HM provider with Epic access before you can register for/attend a Personalization Lab.
- If you can't log in to Epic, the instructor may cancel your Personalization Lab, since you'll need Epic access to complete personalization.
- Course names read as "Epic New Hire" but are available to all current HM providers with Epic access.

Instructions

- 1. Personalization labs are based on specialty. Refer to **pages 2 and 3** of this document to locate your specialty.
- 2. Log in to the LMS SuccessFactors site, click the Find Learning tile.
- 3. In the search field, enter the Course Number or Course Name.
- 4. Click the Go button.
- 5. Hover your mouse over the course, click the **Register** hyperlink.
- 6. The instructor will email your virtual personalization session link to the email address on file at least 24 hours prior to the start of class.
